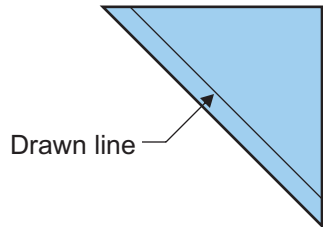


Flying Geese with HSTs and a Rectangle

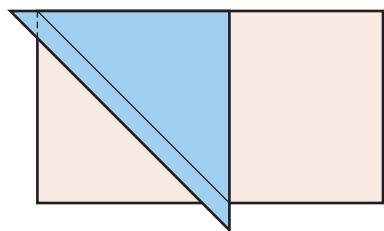
Take two HSTs and draw a 1/4" sewing seam line on the wrong side of the fabric.



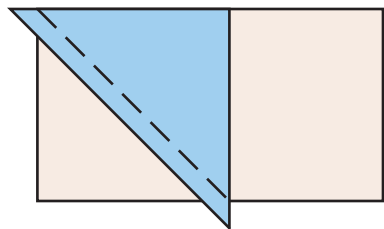
Special Note:
You will be drawing along a bias edge. Be very careful not to stretch the fabric.

Line up end of drawn line to corner of rectangle below

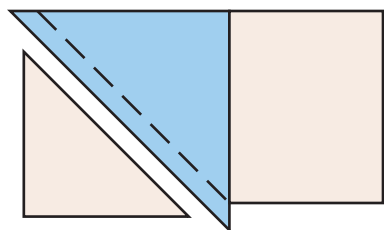
Lay a HST over the rectangle with the right sides together.



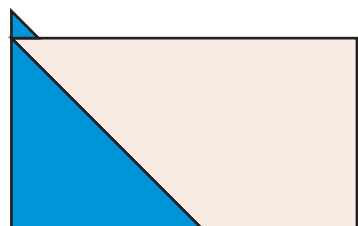
Sew along the drawn line as indicated in diagram.



Cut off the corner of the rectangle fabric.

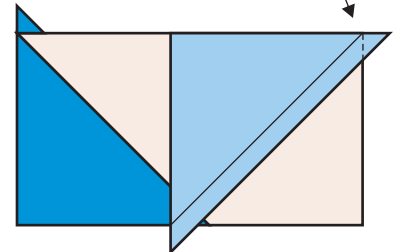


Fold back the triangle and press seam towards the rectangle.

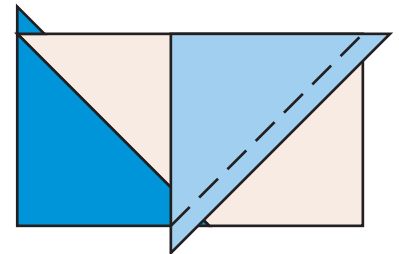


Line up end of drawn line to corner of rectangle below

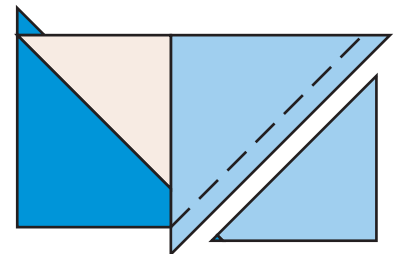
Lay the other HST over the rectangle with the right sides together.



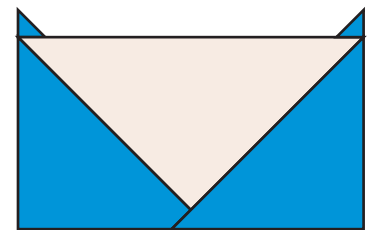
Sew along the drawn line as indicated in diagram.



Cut off the corner of the rectangle fabric.



Fold back the triangle and press the seam towards the rectangle.



Cut off the ears as shown in diagram.
