Baskets and More Baskets - Introduction

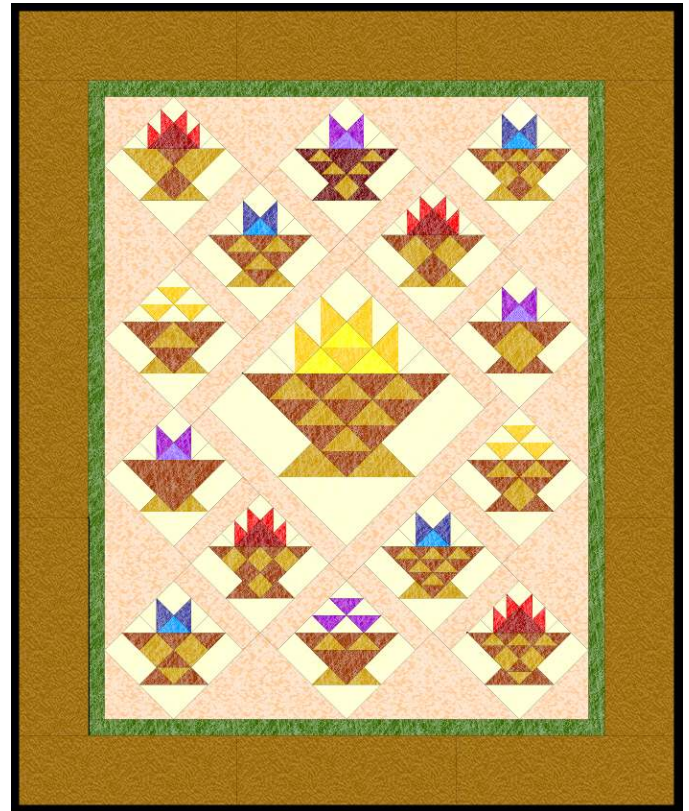
This patchwork BOM is a lovely assortment of baskets. Each basket has the same general shape. However, each one is unique in the way the basket and the flower are pieced together.

Cindy designed this BOM so that you can test and refine your piecing skills! With each installment, the number of pieces per basket and the difficulty level will increase. If you are a novice quilter, this is the perfect project to expand your skills. If you are an experienced quilter, you will appreciate the increasing complexity of the blocks.

Materials Required:

(42" - 44" quilting cottons recommended)

- ◆ 1 yd light brown for baskets *
- ◆ 1 yd dark brown for baskets*
- ◆ Fat quarter of gold for flowers
- ◆ Plump 8th of each of the following colors for flowers (plump 8th = 11" x 18" = 1/2 fat quarter):

light blue	light purple	light red
dark blue	dark purple	dark red
yellow		
- ◆ 2-1/2 yd for block background*
- ◆ 2 yds for sashing and setting triangles*
- ◆ 2/3 yd for pieced inner border
- ◆ 2-1/2 yds for pieced outer border
- ◆ 3 yd 90" wide backing (or 6 yd 44" wide)
- ◆ 3 yd 90" wide batting (queen size)
- ◆ 3/4 yd binding

* **Note:** Additional yardage may be required if you choose to use an assortment of fabrics.
